Working closely with Cape Henlopen High School's Homeless Liaison, Social Worker and Nurse, COK delivered clothing for their students in need. To ensure COK was providing outfits that high schoolers would wear, Volunteer Buyer Robyn Dagen met with the CHHS staff to fill their closet. Most of the funds for the items were supplied through a Grant from COK devoted partners at TCCGives. Hence, the large \$5,000 check held by Robyn in the picture below. Because of this generous Grant COK can stock CHHS's closet now and keep it stocked throughout the school year.

Sadly, COK has heard of a boy who dropped out of CHHS due to bullying. When pressed about his absence, the boy advised he was constantly harassed about the way he was dressed. Clothing insecurity can have a significant impact on a student's life, and this is just one example. CHHS tells us that they receive emergency government funds for shelter and food but nothing for clothing. That's where COK fits in.
