The Sussex County Community is doing its part to ensure a hopeful future for the students supported by Clothing Our Kids (COK). COK was blessed during the Holiday Sesson with generous donations from businesses and individuals. These funds come at a time when the demand for essential school clothing is at an all-time high. Clothing purchases in the month of December were \$14,000 with COK supplying clothing to the Head Start, Pre-K, Elementary, and Middle School students in the County. That does not include the High School Program initiated in the 2023/2024 School Year. COK is currently serving Cape Henlopen, Sussex Central, Woodbridge and is bringing on Laurel and Seaford High Schools at the start of this new year. Seaford has the highest student poverty rate in the County at 19.8% with Laurel second at 18.9%

Delaware Curative Workshop is a private foundation located in Greenville, Delaware that primarily funds good works/charity through grants. The purpose of Delaware Curative Workshop is to fulfill the underserved or unserved needs in the community through donor directed funds. The Workshop generously provided COK with a \$8,000 grant in December as one of our largest contributors.

Others include \$4,500 from an Anonymous Donor with Conley United Methodist Women's Group and All Saints Parish Thrift Shop both donating \$1,000 each. Tidemark Federal Credit Union rounded out the large business donations at \$500. The balance came from generous individuals. On behalf of the students we serve, a big thank you to all our friends and neighbors.

Clothing Our Kids is an Official 501(c)(3) Approved organization whose Mission is to improve the lives of atrisk Head Start, Pre-K, Elementary, Middle School and now High School students by providing them with appropriate school clothing. Education is crucial in pulling kids out of poverty. Being distracted by the lack of adequate clothing holds these youngsters back from making the most of their learning abilities. It is imperative for these students to feel good about going to school and that is the role filled by COK. Providing a better life through education is imperative.
